The Mezuzah symbolizes; dedication to the commandments, sanctification of the home, divine protection, love of God, and, an affirmation of faith and Jewish identity.

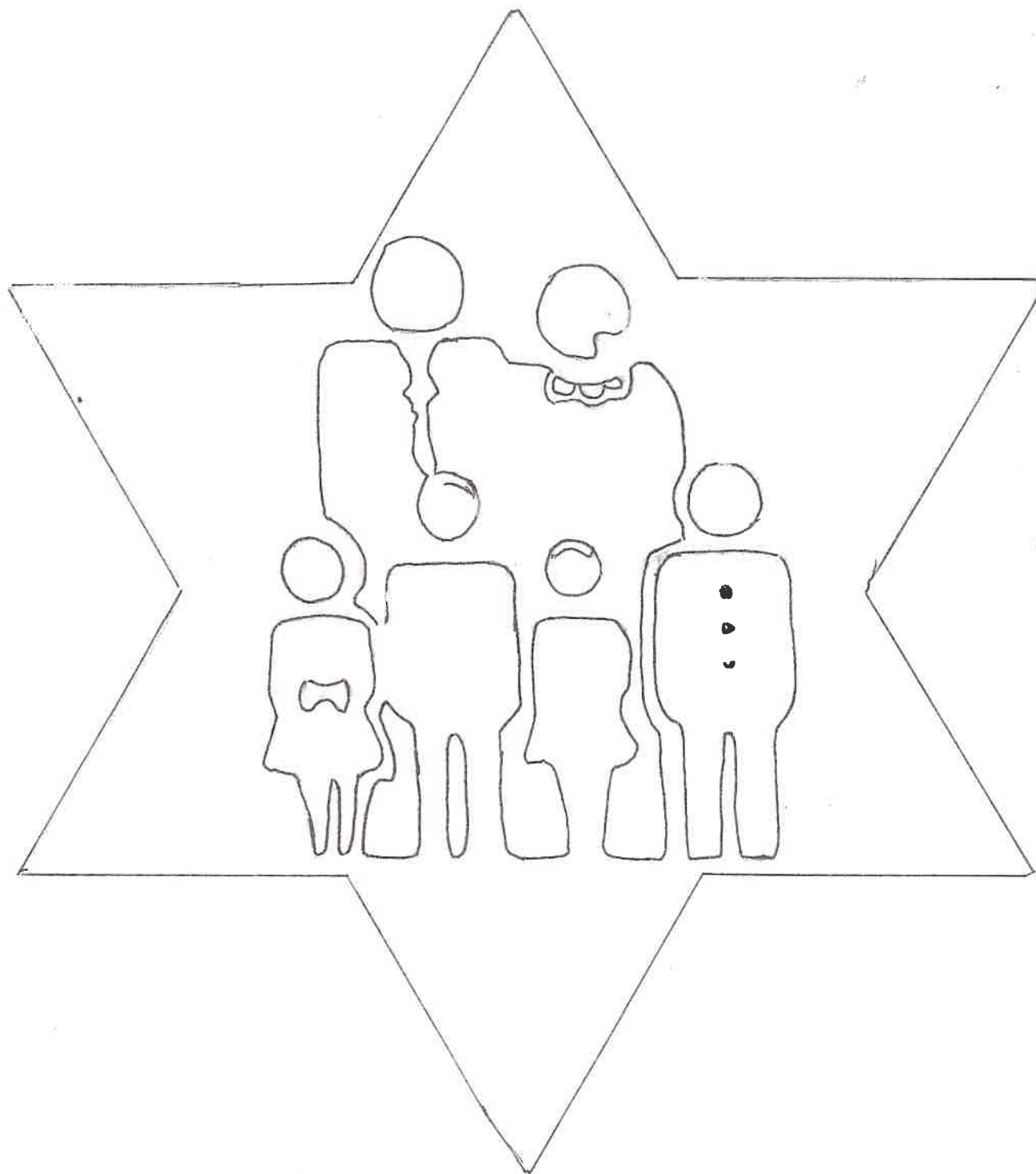
